

CROATIAN ARCHITECTS MAKE RETURN VISIT TO TRIESTE

A group of about twenty members of the Department of Architects of the Croatian Chamber of Architects and Civil Engineers, lead by Chairwoman of the Department Helena Knific Schaps, returned last weekend a visit to the colleagues of the Chamber of Architects of the city of Trieste as a part of a cultural exchange program. With this visit the Department of Architects confirmed an excellent cooperation with their Italian colleagues, especially with Luciano Lazzari, Chairman of the Chamber of Architects of the city of Trieste and honorary member of our Department.

After Luciano Semerani's introductory lecture about the historical development of the city followed the viewing of the most representative and the most interesting buildings in the city and in its surroundings, especially those dating back to the period from the 1930's to the 1950's. Croatian architects were especially honoured with a reception hosted by Roberto Dipiazza, mayor of Trieste, who, along with the welcoming words, briefly outlined plans, failures and actual aspects of town management.

The stay at Trieste was accompanied with nice and sunny weather. This made the atmosphere of the sojourn even more relaxed and impressions more intense, as well as the wish for continuing cooperation based on architectural programs.
