ITALIAN ARCHITECT ENCHANTED WITH ZAGREB

April 15.,16. i 17.2005.

Architects from three Italian provinces – Trieste, Pordenone and Gorizia – visited their Zagreb counterparts last weekend and were stunned by cultural beauties of the Croatian capital. During their three-day stay, the Italians took a tour of Gornji and Donji grad (old upper and lower city) and Novi Zagreb, paying special attention to Croatian modernism and 20th century architecture.

Tidiness, orderliness and architecture of Zagreb pleasantly surprised the Italians, but they were most impressed by hospitality and openness of inhabitants of Zagreb. President of an Order of the Croatian Chamber of Architects and Civil Engineers, Zlatko Hanžek, received his Italian colleagues, while architects Aleksander Laslo and Sanja Filep served as expert guides through the city.

Representative of the Order of Architects of the three Italian provinces and coordinator of 13 orders of architects, Luciano Lazzari, declared he anxiously awaited the return visit of his Zagreb colleagues to Trieste.
